

Chapter 4



Do's and Don'ts

1. **DO** remember each fall to disconnect your outdoor hose and turn off the outside water before the first freeze. The outside water shut off is usually located in your laundry room by the water heater. Bills to fix frozen pipes are the homeowner's responsibility.
2. **DO** pick up after your pet. Remember to carry bags with you to dispose of the waste.
3. **DO** keep your pet on a leash at all times.
4. **DO** stay with any guests you bring to the pool. An owner must be present at all times with their pool guests.
5. **DON'T** leave any items at the pool. All personal items left at the pool will be discarded.
6. **DO** remember that according to the Health Department, unless there is a licensed lifeguard on duty, no one may be in the pool unless there is one other person in the pool area.
7. **DO** keep your garbage cans in your garage except on garbage collection day which is every Tuesday, except during the following holiday weeks when the garbage will be picked up on Wednesday.
 - New Years
 - Memorial Day
 - Fourth of July
 - Labor Day
 - Thanksgiving
 - Christmas
6. **DON'T** use the guest parking areas for your "driveway" They are reserved for guests and we don't want our community to have the appearance of a parking lot!
7. **DON'T** allow Community Center party rental guests to use the pool or enter the gate into the pool area. Guests present during a party for which the Community Center was rented are not allowed into the pool area.
